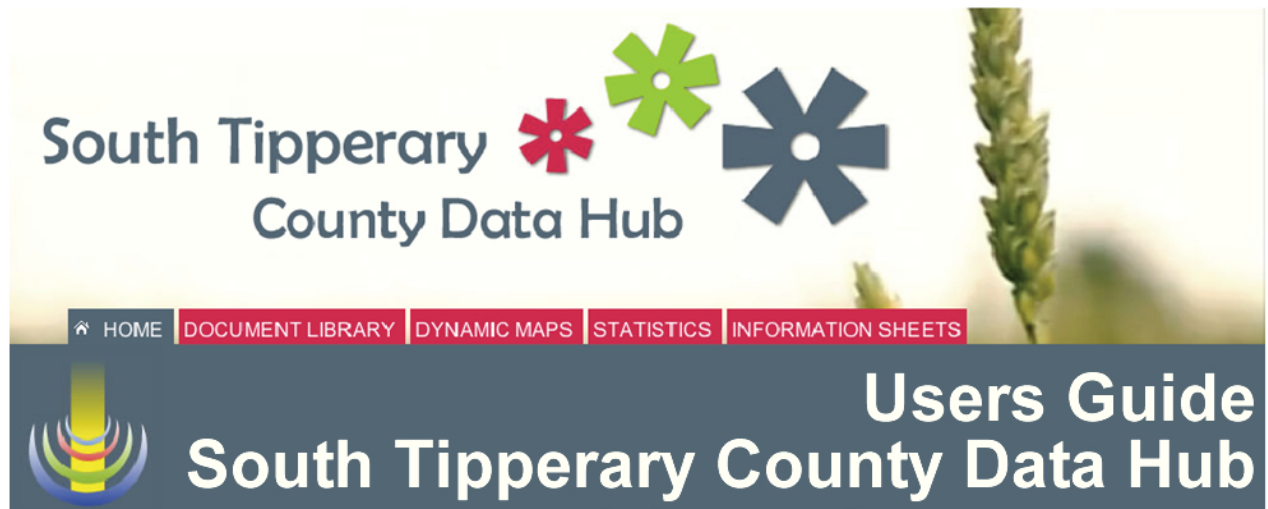


South Tipperary County Data Hub **Users Guide**

The aim of the South Tipperary County Data Hub is to provide a one-stop-shop for information that is helpful to decision-making for agencies and organisations in the county. We hope that it will not only be of benefit to community groups, but will also assist with coordination between local authorities and agencies, and more generally with the delivery of public services.

The South Tipperary County Data Hub is an initiative of South Tipperary County Development Board. We will ensure that the information is kept as up to date as possible.

Getting Started...

This screen provides you with a way of navigating through the South Tipperary County Data Hub.



The **Document Library** contains an extensive range of policy publications provided by the agencies that have helped us create the Data Hub. These are policy documents that help describe the future vision for our county, and can be used to help you with research.

The **Dynamic Maps** section brings together mapping from our technical partners, AIRO and Pobal. The County Data Hub has linked with Pobal to provide a wide variety of demographic and socio-economic mapping information.

As part of a research project, AIRO developed a mapping module of the 2011 Census data for South Tipperary using interactive mapping and data analysis tools. The County Data Hub has formed links with CSO SAPMAP, Heritage Maps, and Development and Local Area Plan mapping through MyPlan.ie. South Tipperary County Council GIS Section designed a bespoke suite of interactive maps based on local authority service provision.

The **Statistics** section provides you with a way to create your own reports from the Central Statistics Office (CSO) Census data (1991-2011) for each of the EDs of our county.

Using sources including the Pobal HP Deprivation Index for Small Areas, developed by Haase and Pratschke, the **Information Sheets** section brings a small number of basic socio-economic and demographic information sheets that you can build in to your own reports.

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Document Library...

This is the entry screen to the Document Library.



These are the themes that we have used to store the documents in the Document Library. These are displayed in a drop-down menu when you click on the 'Select Theme' box: -

Community	Policing
Education	Social
Enterprise	Strategic Planning
Environment	Training
Health Infrastructure	General Information

You can also select documents by the agency that is responsible for them. These are displayed in a drop-down menu when you click on the 'Select Agency' box.

Dynamic Maps...

The Dynamic Maps allow you to look at a wide variety of demographic and socio-economic data on a map of the county. This will allow you to compare differences between EDs across the county.

The map sections include:

- Pobal Maps:** Pobal Maps are a suite of maps and analytical tools showing the HP Deprivation Index, census data and other programmes.
- National Institute for Regional & Spatial Analysis:** AIRO Maps present census data for the county in an interactive mapping format and enable users to filter data based on location and the 2011 census data.
- South Tipperary County Council Maps:** This is a series of custom designed maps showing facilities and services provided by the local authority.
- CSO Small Area Statistical Mapping:** SAPMAPS is a mapping initiative of the CSO providing 2011 census data based on the location selected by the user.
- MyPlan Map Viewer:** The MyPlan.ie website functions as a one stop shop on all aspects of planning decision-making (census, heritage sites, patterns of housing development etc.).
- Heritage Map Viewer:** Heritage Maps show cultural and natural interest datasets related to heritage, which users may filter and cross reference.

The footer contains four sections: Documents (Search, copy, print any document from our library by theme or agency. >>), Maps (View, analyse and print maps and statistical factsheets >>), Statistics (Access, view, print and copy town/village census data visual factsheets >>), and Information Sheets (View information sheets on socio-economic and demographic data for the county. >>).

All of these Interactive Mapping and Data Analysis Tools are really powerful ways of visualising the socio-economic and demographic indicators for our county, overlaid on maps. Use these tools to create an easy to understand statistical picture of the county, and to help your audience to understand your message.

South Tipperary County Council has also supplied a set of specially commissioned maps of the county to show a range of environmental and infrastructural information that may be of value to you in your research and presentation.

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Statistics...

The Statistics tool allows you to look at a range of CSO Census themes and data as a trend graph using the 1981-2011 census returns for each of the EDs of the county. This will allow you to compare differences between EDs across the county, and the county as a whole.

Statistics

Local census information is presented in graphical and interactive formats.

Local Census Data

This section presents visual factsheets of the 2011 census data categorised by towns and large villages and covering fifteen census themes, including population, age and household composition. County, regional and national comparatives are also included.

Users may filter the data using the selection and menu options at the top of the page, with options to print, export, or copy the visual factsheet.

Local Census Trend Data

This section includes census data from 1991-2011 to enable users to produce a series of graphical factsheets, showing variations in the census records for each town/village against those of the county.

Users may analyse CSO Census data from 1991, 1996, 2002, 2006 and 2011 for each of the towns/villages of the county.

A graphical factsheet shows how each town/village compares against the county indicator, with options print, copy the graphical factsheet or export the data for further analysis.

They are not meant to be exhaustive, and do not provide extensive analysis, but may help in providing foundation material for some of your own reports and research.
