<p>Comments and recommendations made by the inspection team as a result of the inspection</p>	<p>The Nursing Home Inspection and Registration Team commend the completion of the first phase of development and upgrading of the home and acknowledge that there is a plan to address the following issues in the next phase.</p> <p>As per previous report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is recommended that additional screening curtains be provided in shared bedrooms. • In the interests of health and safety, grab rails should be installed in all en-suite toilets. • Ensure that all beds have overhead lights which are accessible • Window blinds are recommended in room 20 to ensure privacy and roof blinds could be considered for the conservatory to help eliminate glare. <p>As discussed at this inspection ensure that all policies are updated regularly using research based best practice</p>
